


Your Hearing Test Check List

Prior to your hearing test appointment please ensure:

- 1. That you minimise your risk of exposure to extended periods of loud noise (<80dB) for 16 hours before your test. If there is a chance you may be exposed to loud noise it is important that you wear ear plugs/earmuffs to ensure the accuracy of your test.
- 2. If you have a history of ear wax build up, please see your family doctor to have this cleared a minimum of two days before your test

If you are unable to have your test due to wax occlusion, your employer may still be charged for this assessment. It will also cause an inconvenience to both your employer and you to reschedule and return for a second booking.

Please note: the test may not be able to be performed if the audiometric officer deems a cold/flu may affect your hearing.
